

NEW: Renew Your Troop Using Cookie Dough!

Parent/guardians can opt to renew their Girl Scouts with Cookie Dough, using [this form for returning girls](#), or [this form if their Girl Scout is graduating this year](#).

Leaders, use the directions below to request renewal with Cookie Dough on behalf of girls in your troop. Click here for directions on renewing members through MyGS (without Cookie Dough).

1. First, you'll need to get permission from parents/guardians to use individual girls' Cookie Dough to renew their membership for the 2017-18 year. Use the Renewal Roster (included later in this document) to easily track plans for next year. *You can also collect permission via email, collect names and signatures on a sheet of notebook paper, etc. – whatever is most convenient for your troop!*
2. After you have permission, go to the super simple [Troop Renewal with Cookie Dough Form](#) and list the Girl Scouts who will renew using their Cookie Dough.
 - *Important: If you are requesting renewal on behalf of troop members, using Cookie Dough, please make sure at least one troop leader has also renewed, with an eligible background check on file.*
3. You'll receive confirmation of each troop member who renews in the troop, once memberships have been processed (this may take up to 3 weeks).
4. You may have some parents/guardians who would prefer not to use their Girl Scout's Cookie Dough to renew. Troop Leaders can register multiple girls in the troop ([check out more information here](#)), or the parent/guardian can renew their Girl Scout on their own ([check out more information here](#)).
